ADDITIONAL NOTIFICATION FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATION/DIRECT ADMISSION TO Ph.D
PROGRAMME - 2019 (ONLY FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION, COMPUTER SCIENCE &
AQUACULTURE AND FISHERY MICROBIOLOGY DISCIPLINES)

Applications are invited from eligible candidates including candidates exempted from entrance test for admission to the Ph.D programme under the streams (1) Full-time and (2) Part-time under the faculties of **Physical Education, Computer Science & Aquaculture and Fishery Microbiology** of this University (**Candidates should verify vacancy position published in www.cuonline.ac.in, prior to the payment of application fee**).

1.ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

1.1 Candidates for admission to the Ph.D. programme shall have a Masters degree or a Professional degree recognized as equivalent to the Masters degree of the University of Calicut, with at least grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or at least 55% marks in aggregate in the mark system or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in it's home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.

1.2 A relaxation of 10% of marks, from 55% to 45%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, shall be allowed to candidates belonging to SC/ST category. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, shall be allowed to those belonging to OBC (non-creamy layer) / differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decisions of the University/State Government from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991.

1.3 Eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of marks / grades to the categories as mentioned in Clause 1.2 above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks exclusive of the grace mark procedures.

1.4 Candidates who have passed the M.Phil. Degree programme with a minimum of grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent shall be eligible to proceed to do research work leading to the Ph.D. Degree in the same institution. A relaxation of 10% of marks, from 55% to 45%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, shall be allowed to candidates belonging to SC/ST category. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, shall be allowed to those belonging to OBC (non-creamy layer) / differently-abled and other categories of

candidates, as decided by the State government / University from time to time.

1.5 A candidate whose M.Phil. dissertation has been evaluated and the viva voce is pending may be admitted to the Ph.D. programme of the same institution

1.6 Candidates possessing a Degree considered equivalent to M.Phil. degree of an Indian Institution, from a Foreign Educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D. programme.

1.7 Persons working in National Laboratories - Institutes / Universities / Government Organization nominated / sponsored by the respective employer; Teachers of the University / Government or Aided Colleges affiliated to the University / Govt. or Aided Secondary and Higher Secondary School within the geographical jurisdiction of the University and holding a permanent position there shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D. programme, provided they satisfy the conditions of Clause 1.1.

2. ENTRANCE TEST

2.1 Research Departments may conduct the entrance test.

2.2 All the candidates getting a minimum of 50% marks and in the case of SC/ST categories of candidates a minimum of 40% marks and in the case of OBC (non-creamy layer) / differently-abled and other categories of candidates a minimum of 45% marks, as the case may be, in the entrance test are qualified to apply for registration to Ph.D. Programme.

3. EXEMPTION FROM ENTRANCE TEST

3.1 Candidates who qualify UGC-NET/JRF, UGC-CSIR-NET/JRF, SLET, GATE and research fellowships of Central and State Government departments / agencies as approved by the University, as the case may be

3.2 Full time regular teachers of the University departments / Govt. or Aided Colleges affiliated to the University of Calicut and teachers with FDP / QIP or similar fellowships

3.3 Foreign nationals who are otherwise eligible for admission

3.4 Full-time fellows, who have been selected on the basis of a written test and interview, working in a research project under the investigation of a research guide of the University

3.5 M.Phil. Degree (successfully completed from any Statutory Recognized University in the relevant subject) holders

3.6 The candidates mentioned in clauses 3.1 to 3.4 can apply for Ph.D. registration at any time during the academic year depending on the willingness / availability of guides.

4. ADMISSION

4.1 Students who have been shortlisted after the entrance examination, or otherwise eligible, shall apply to the Department / Centre / Affiliated Colleges directly in the prescribed forms along with application fee for admission.

4.2 The application fee shall be remitted to the Calicut University Fund and the forms will be issued by the University.

5. REGISTRATION

5.1 The qualified candidate may contact the teaching / research department / centre / recognized institutes / affiliated college, where he / she prefers to pursue the Ph.D course, and seek the availability and willingness of the research guide who is competent in the area in which he / she is willing to do research and work with him / her to develop a research proposal.

5.2 Candidates eligible for registration to Ph.D. shall be decided by a two stage process – Entrance Test and Interview / Viva-Voce.

6. COURSE WORK

7. PROCEDURE OF APPLICATION

7.1 Applications can be submitted online upto 31.12.2018 midnight. Please see the link '*Fee Remittance*' in the Admission Website (www.cuonline.ac.in) or the link '*Instant Web Payment System (CUIWPS)*' in the Official Website of the University (www.uoc.ac.in) for remitting fee and submitting online application. The application and entrance examination fee of Rs.580/- (SC/ST - Rs.235/-) shall be remitted to Calicut University Fund (*Select the purpose ' ADM 131 - Application and Entrance examination fee for Ph.D admission 2019*) by e-payment (SBI online/SBI e-chalan / Friends / Akshaya e-chalan / Payment Gateway) .

7.2 All Candidates including entrance exempted candidates, shall register online for seeking admission to Ph.D programme 2019.

7.3 The printout of the application duly attested along with e-challan receipt of Rs.580/- (Rs.235/- for SC/ST candidates) towards application and Entrance Examination fee (SC/ST candidates shall also attach a copy of the community certificate along with application) **should reach the Head of the University Teaching Departments / Entrance conducting authority concerned on or before 4th January 2019, 5.00 PM (Address of the University Teaching Departments / Entrance conducting authority is given in Annexure I).**

8. HALL TICKETS FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATION.

The Online Registration ID No. is mandatory for downloading hall tickets for the entrance examinations. **This ID No. should be noted in all future communications by the candidate.** The candidates can download hall tickets for the entrance examination from www.cuonline.ac.in (Please see the link 'Entrance Courses') 3 days before the date of entrance examination. No individual communication regarding entrance exam will be sent to the candidates and the candidates shall go through the University Websites and the University Press release for the latest information.

9. OTHER CONDITIONS

9.1 Admission is possible only against the notified vacancies.

9.2 Those who want to appear for Entrance Exam in 2 different disciplines should contact the Departments concerned. In such cases the Departments concerned will conduct entrance examinations in two different sessions on the same day fixed for the entrance examination. (i.e., one exam in the forenoon and the other in the afternoon).

9.3 Candidates who wish to apply for two different disciplines, which require separate entrance examination has to apply and pay the fees separately.
