<u>Procedures for the admission of International Students (Foreign Students) to Under Graduate or Post Graduate Programmes offered at University Teaching Departments and Colleges affiliated to the University of Calicut.</u>

Procedures

- 1. The candidate can submit application, along with the copies of documents such as mark lists/grade cards, certificates to prove his / her eligibility / qualifications for the course along with the equivalency certificate of the qualifying course issued by Assosiation of Indian Universities(AIU) or this University, if any, by post or by email or directly to the University; He / she should also submit the copies of relevent pages of Passport / Visa.
- 2. The appropriate bodies of the University will verify the applications and documents to ascertain the eligibility of the applicants and will inform the eligibility / non-eligibility of the student to the course.
- 3. If eligible, the University will issue a letter to the student or to the sponsor with direction to take admission by producing all the original documents such as Certificates, Mark Lists / Grade Cards, Original Passport, Valid Student/Research Visa etc.
- 4. On arrival of the student, the University will verify the original documents and,if satisfied, will issue an order to take admission in an affiliated college / University Department, according to the choice of the student and according to the availability of seats.
- 5. The candidate can take admission in the affiliated colleges / University Departments as per the order by paying required fees.

- 7. The students are liable to report to the Foreigners Regional Registration Officer (FRRO) on their arrival in India within the stipulated time period as per their nationality and visa.
- 8. The students are liable to obey all the rules and regulations laid down by the college, the University, the State Government and the Central Government, violation of which will lead to his/her eviction from this country.

Instructions to be Followed

- 1. The applications of International Students for admission to Under Graduate or Post Graduate programmes should reach the office of Dean of Students Welfare on or before 30th April by mail / by post / by hand / by online.
- 2. The candidate shall produce the original Certificates, mark lists / grade cards, original passport, valid student / research visa etc. at the time of reporting for admission.
- 3. The candidate may produce the Medical check up report at the time of reporting for admission.
- 4. The student or the sponsor should pay the required fee as per the fee strucutre, which is available in the official Website of the University, after getting admission and submit the challan receipt for the Registration fee paid in the office of Dean of Students Welfare. He should produce reciepts / challans of other fees to the Head of the Institution / Department, where he/she took admission.
- 5. The students shall report to the Foreigners Regional Registration Officer (FRRO) on their arrival in India within the stipulated time period as per their nationality and visa.
- 6. The students should obey all rules and regulations laid down by the college, the University, the State Government and the Central Government, violation of which will lead to his / her eviction from this country.
- 7. As per the direction of the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR), the students sponsored by the ICCR will be admitted only to the Government / Aided Colleges or University Departments, as per their choice. They will not be admitted to Un-aided / Self-Financing Colleges.
- 8. International students should not have any membership in any of the local / State / National Organizations working for Social / Religious / Political causes, etc.
