NOTIFICATION FOR ADMISSION TO M.PHIL PROGRAMME - 2019

Applications are invited from eligible candidates including candidates exempted from entrance test for admission to the M.Phil programmes in the University Teaching Departments for the following subjects: Arabic, Biotechnology, Botany, Women's Studies, Chemistry, Commerce, Computer Science, Economics, Education, English, Hindi, History, Journalism & Mass Communication, Library and Information Science, Life Sciences (Physiology, Microbiology and Biochemistry), Malayalam & Kerala Studies, Mathematics, Philosophy, Physics, Political Science, Psychology, Sanskrit, Drama & Fine Arts (Theatre), Folklore Studies, Statistics, Zoology.

Candidates should verify vacancy position published in www.cuonline.ac.in, prior to the payment of application fee.

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

1.1 Candidates for admission to the M.Phil. programme shall have a Masters degree or an professional degree declared equivalent to the Masters degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7 point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.

1.2 A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (noncreamy layer)/ Differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Masters degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.

2. ENTRANCE TEST

2.1 Candidates eligible for registration to M.Phil. shall be decided by an Entrance Test. **Entrance Test shall be conducted at the University Departments on the dates notified.**

2.2 A minimum of 40% marks in entrance test is necessary for qualifying the Entrance. Admission shall be made from the rank list based on the percentage of marks/grade. Admission is possible only against the notified vacancies.

2.3 Syllabus of the Entrance Test will be only from the concerned PG syllabus, with 50% objective and 50% descriptive questions.

3. EXEMPTION FROM ENTRANCE TEST

UGC- CSIR - JRF Fellowship holders are exempted from Entrance Test and 1 (one) seat will be reserved for JRF holders.

4. DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME

M.Phil. programme shall be for a minimum duration of two consecutive semesters/one year.

5. COURSE WORK

7. PROCEDURE OF APPLICATION

7.1 Applications can be submitted online from 10.04.2019 to 26.04.2019 midnight. Please see the link 'Fee Remittance' in the Admission Website (www.cuonline.ac.in) or the link 'Instant Web Payment System (CUIWPS)' in the Official Website of the University (www.uoc.ac.in) for remitting fee and submitting online application. **The application and entrance examination fee of Rs.555/-**

(SC/ST - Rs.190/-) shall be remitted to Calicut University Fund (Select the purpose ' **MPHILSW19 - Application and Entrance examination fee for M.Phil admission 2019** ') by e-payment (SBI online/SBI e-chalan /Friends/Akshaya e-chalan) .

7.2 **All Candidates** including entrance exempted candidates shall register online for admission to M.Phil programme 2019.

7.3 The print out of the application duly attested by a gazetted officer along with e-challan receipt of Rs.555/- (Rs.190/-for SC/ST candidates) towards application and Entrance Examination fee (SC/ST candidates shall also attach a copy of the community certificate along with application) should reach the Head of the University Teaching Departments concerned on or before 29th April 2019, 5.00 PM (Address of the University Teaching Departments is given in **Annexure I**).

8. HALL TICKETS FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATION.

CAP ID allotted during the registration process is mandatory for downloading hall tickets for the entrance examinations. This CAP ID should be noted in all future communications by the candidate. The candidates can download hall tickets for the entrance examination from www.cuonline.ac.in (Please see the link 'Entrance Courses') 3 days before the date of entrance examination. **No individual communication regarding entrance exam will be sent to the candidates and the candidates shall go through the University Websites and the University Press release for the latest information.**
