Conditions and Guidelines:-

- 1. The ethnic native Lakshadweep candidates are exempted from the entrance examinations based on the sponsorship letter from the Lakshadweep Administration, subject to eligibility.
- 2. A fee of Rs.350/- (SC/ST Rs.150/-) with a late application fee of Rs 265/- shall be remitted to Calicut University Fund by e-payment (SBI online/SBI e-chalan/Friends/Akshaya e-chalan/Payment gateway). Please click the link "fee remittance" in the Admission Website (www.cuonline.ac.in) or the link "Instant Web Payment System" in the Official Website of the University (www.universityofcalicut.info) for remitting fee. Choose the purpose of remittance while processing the challan.
- 3. A candidate, if eligible, may register upto six separate programmes within ten options by using single registration fee. If the candidate applied for six programmes, separate print out shall be sent to the department concerned.
- 4. Apply online (from 30.07.2018 to 04.08.2018) through the website www.cuonline.ac.in. Click on the link 'Entrance Courses '. Enter challan number and pass word and go ahead for completing the registration process.
- 5. The online Registration I.D.No. is mandatory for downloading hall tickets for the entrance examinations. This I.D.No should also be kept and mentioned by the candidate in all future communications. Hence, the candidates are advised to keep a copy of the print out of the application also with them for reference as well as to produce the same whenever required.
- 6. Those who are awaiting the results of the qualifying examination can also apply. They have to submit the copies of Marklist/Grade card to the Head/Director/Co-ordinator, as the case may be, in order to finalise the Rank list in stipulated time.
- 7. Candidates are permitted to submit marklist/grade card of the qualifying examination at least 45 days from the commencement of class for the programmes, if admission is based on marks of the entrance examination only.
- 8. The Heads/Co-ordinators are authorized to conduct Entrance and admissions as per rules.
- 9. No memo will be sent to the candidates in respect of entrance examination, entrance examination result, Counselling etc. Candidates shall update themselves with the University Website (www.cuonline.ac.in/www.universityofcalicut.info) and with the University Press releases for the latest information.
- 10. The type of questions can be objective only, descriptive only or a combination of objective and descriptive questions. If the entrance examination includes objective type questions alone, 1/3 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer. If it includes combination of objective type and descriptive type questions or descriptive questions only no negative scores that is no deduction of marks for wrong answers.
- 11. The admitted candidates shall provide marklist of the qualifying examination at least 45 days from the date of admission, otherwise the student concerned should relinquish the seat. Students should provide a signed declaration in this regard at the time of admission.
- 12. The duration of the entrance examination has to be 2 hours.
- 13. The syllabus and Question Paper of entrance examination shall be based on the UG Degree syllabus of Calicut University.

14. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass mark/grade.
