Notification for admission to MA Urdu programme 2020-22.

Applications are invited from eligible students for admission to **MA Urdu** (Regular) programme (2 year - Four Semesters) at the Department of Urdu , University of Calicut.

I. Eligibility for Admission : BA degrees in Urdu/ Urdu Language and Literature/Urdu with Computer Application and Multilingual DTP/ Urdu & Islamic History with at least 45% marks in Part III (excluding subsidiaries)/ Core Courses, OR BA/B.Sc (excluding alternative/ LRP pattern) Degree with at least 45% marks in Urdu under part II/ Common Courses of this University, or equivalent Degree. For candidates under Grading System, overall CGPA should be at least equivalent to 50%.

NOTE : OBC/OEC candidates are eligible for relaxation upto 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

No rounding up of marks to obtain minimum eligibility will be allowed.

5% weightage shall be given to BA degree holders in Urdu/Urdu Language and Literature/Urdu with

Computer Application and Multilingual DTP/Urdu & Islamic History and all other degree holders who have studied Urdu as one of their Core courses.

III. Reservation : The seats under Open/SC/ST/SEBC reservation will be as per the prevailing rules of University / Government issued from time to time. All other rules will be applicable for admission as per the PG Entrance 2020 notification unless otherwise specified.

(i). **Open Quota :** The open quota seats will be filled purely on merit basis irrespective of the category/community to which the candidate belongs.

(ii). **Claims for Mandatory Reservations :** Claims for Mandatory Reservations must be made by the candidate in the relevant column of the application. The claims for mandatory reservation once made in the Application form cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstances.

(iii). **Claim for Communal reservation under 'Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC) :** Reservation of seats to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O.(P) 208/66/Edn. dated 2.5.1966, as amended from time to time. Candidates belonging to Ezhava, Muslim, Other backward Hindus, Latin Catholic other than Anglo Indians and Other backward Christian communities, claiming reservation under SEBC Quota should invariably produce both 'Community' and 'Non Creamy Layer Certificate' obtained from the Village Officer concerned at the time of admission. Candidates whose annual family income is above the amount stipulated by the Government for this purpose from time to time are not eligible for reservation. The seats unavailed by SEBC category candidates will be allotted under open quota.

(iv). **Claim for Reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes Quota :** Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes Quota should obtain caste/community certificate from the Tahasildar.

(v). **EWS Quota :** The seats under EWS reservation will be filled from the registered students belonging to Economically Weaker Sections among Forward Community (U.O.No. 4958/2020/Admn Dated, 29.05.2020 & U.O.No. 7158/2020/Admn Dated, 28.07.2020). A community certificate along with the Income & Assets Certificate (Ref: G.O.(Ms) No.128/2020/HEDN Dated 20.03.2020) issued from Village Officers/ Tahasildar should be produced by the candidates who wish to avail of reservation under EWS category at the time of admission. Please see the appendix for Govt. Order G.O.(Ms)No.128/2020/HEDN Dated 20.03.2020 which includes the format for EWS certificate to be obtained from Village Officers.

(vi). **PH Quota :** 5% seats are reserved for candidates having physical disability for PG Courses in aggregation after scrutinizing the suitability. The candidates having minimum 40% disability certified by the Medical Board be considered for admission to the reserved seats earmarked for the Physically Handicapped students. Such eligible candidates shall be ranked on the basis of the marks secured in the qualifying examination (GAI/A2/9091/1994 Vol. II dated 28.05.2003 & GAI/A2/5752/1998 dated 04.05.2004).

(vii). **'Open All India Quota' :** 10% of sanctioned seats or maximum of 2 seats are created for each course offered at University departments, in addition to the total sanctioned seats, earmarked as 'Open All India Quota' reserved for applicants who are natives of states other than Kerala subject to the following conditions.(U.O No: 3259/2020/Admn dated 11.03.2020)

(i). If there are no applicants for 'Open All India Quota', the additionally created seats shall be cancelled .

(ii). Communal reservation shall not be made applicable for 'Open All India Quota'.

(iii). Applicants for 'Open All India Quota ' shall have to produce a valid nativity certificate issued by competent authority concerned, at the time of admission.

(iv). Candidates under 'Open All India Quota' shall have to fulfill eligibility stipulated for General Category candidates for PG admission.

(v). Candidates who take admission under 'Open All India Quota' shall submit qualifying Mark list/ Grade cards/ Certificates at the time of admission.

(vi). The fees applicable to general candidates are applicable to 'Open All India Quota' students.

*** For the limited purpose of reservation, under this category, candidates belonging to all those communities which do not enjoy communal reservation will be eligible. Candidates who wish to avail reservation under EWS will have to produce at the time of admission a community certificate along with the Income & Assets Certificate (as in annexure of GO.(Ms) No.128/2020/HEDN Dated 20.03.2020) issued from Village Officers.**

IV. PROCEDURE OF APPLICATION :

1. Payment shall be done through the University of Calicut instant web payment system (<https://iwps.uoc.ac.in/>) under the purpose code : "Application fee for admission to M.A.Urdu programme 2020". Application form can be downloaded from www.cuonline.ac.in. Filled in application form along with attested of SSLC, Consolidated Grade Card / Final Mark list, chalan receipt shall be send to email : urdudept@uoc.ac.in on or before **04.02.2021 5.00 pm. No need to send the hard copies of application and certificates.**
2. **Online Registration Fee :**

3. Last date for remittance of registration fee :04.02.2021

4. Students who have successfully completed a Regular PG programme will not be permitted for an additional PG programme in the regular mode. Additional P.G can be taken in all subjects but only through the SDE or Private mode, provided they are eligible as per other criteria of SDE/Private admission (U.O.No.12437/2016/Admn dated 22.10.2016).

5. No fees other than those prescribed by the University/Govt. shall be levied from the students (U.O.No:520/2019/Admn dated 14.01.2019 &Circular No:1680/DOA-ASST-2/2015/Admn, dated 08.02.2019).
