PROSPECTUS

1. Aims and Objectives

University aims of producing socially inclined, morally and ethically upright, professionally skilled and dedicated educators of tomorrow. In addition to the routine curricular programme, University also aims at providing various opportunities and exposure to bring out and develop optimum professional competency.

2. Course of Study

B.Ed. Special Education (Hearing Impaired)

Regular of two years duration (4 semesters) and the total intake is 30.

3. Eligibility for admission:

3.1 Academic Qualification:

1. Bachelors Degree and/or Masters Degree in Sciences/Social Sciences/Humanities under 10+2+3 pattern with 50 % marks in Part I + II+III together/ 50 % marks for Part III alone or Masters Degree with 50% marks or 10+2+5 pattern for integrated M.A/M.S.c Course or 10+2+3+2 pattern for M.Com. However, 10+2+3 pattern is not insisted for BA/BSc degree holders under liberalized scheme of the University of Calicut.

2. Bachelors in Engineering or Technology with 55 % marks.

3. B.A. degree with English Language and Literature/Functional English/Communicate English with 50 % marks for part III or B.A/B.Sc with 50 % marks for Part I English and not less than 50 % marks for Masters degree in English Language and Literature. B.A. English Honours degree from Central Universities or State Universities with 50 % marks recognised by UGC.

4. B.A degree with Malayalam Language and Literature with 50 % marks for part III or B.A/B.Sc with 50 % marks for Part II Malayalam and not less than 50 % marks for Masters degree in Malayalam Language and Literature.

5. B.Sc degree with Mathematics or Statistics or Applied Statistics main with 50 % marks for part III. Candidates with Statistics/ Applied Statistic should have studied Mathematics as one of the subjects.

6. B.Sc Degree with Physics/Physics with Computer application/Chemistry/Chemistry with maths and Computer Application/Polymer Chemistry/Industrial Chemistry/B.SC Geology/Bsc.Petrochemicals/B.Sc. Biochemistry/ Bio Physics/Applied Physics main with 50% marks for part III.

7. B.Sc Degree with Botany/Zoology/B.Sc Biochemistry/B.Sc. Plant Science/B.Sc. Family and Community Science with Zoology or Botany as subsidiary/Aqua Cultrue with Biochemistry and Zoology as subsidiaries/ Biotechnology/Microbiology/Genetics/Food Technology/B.Sc.Agriculture with Biochemistry and Zoology as subsidiaries with 50% marks for part III.

8. B.A Degree with History/Islamic History/Arabic and Islamic History main with 50% marks for Part III or B.A degree with Geography/Politics/Economics/Economics with Developmental Economics/Economics with Foreign Trade/Economics with Islamic Finance/Sociology/Psychology/Philosophy/West Asian Studies/Public Administration with 50 % marks under part III. MSW with 50 % mark.

9. Bachelor Degree with Geography as main subject under part III with 50 % marks.

10. Candidates who have secured M.Com Degree with not less than 50 % marks alone are eligible for admission.

11. Home Science candidates, who have secured M.Sc. Degree in Home Science with not less than 50 % alone are eligible for admission to the B.Ed course.

12. MCA/M.Sc Computer Science /M.Sc Electronics/ with a minimum of 50 marks. MBA with 55 % marks in aggregate.

13. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from other Universities outside Kerala should submit Equivalency Certificate at the time of admission stating that their qualifying examination is recognized as equivalent to the University of Calicut, for seeking admission to B.Ed Degree Special Education (HI) course .

14. Double or Triple main candidates or candidates who passed the Degree Examination in Vocational or Specialized Courses are also eligible for admission. However, they have submit Equivalency Certificate at the time of admission.

15. Any other qualification equivalent thereto OR the eligibility requirements,rules and regulations of B.Ed programme admission fixed by the University of Calicut from time to time.

4. Relaxation in marks.

The reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other categories shall be as per the rules of Central Government/State Government, whichever is applicable.

5. Mandatory Reservation: Reservation rules of the course are as follows:

5.1 Scheduled Caste - 8 % of seats and Scheduled Tribe - 2 %

In case sufficient eligible applicants under SC/ST quota are not available, the same will be filled up in the following priority

SC seats : By ST/Lakshadweep/OEC candidates

ST seats : By Lakshadweep/SC/OEC candidates

5.2 Socially and Educationally Backward Classes : 30 %

50 % of the seats will be filled up on the basis of merit and by following the reservation policy of the state Government as given in the table below. The remaining 50 % can be filled up by the educational agency(Management Quota).

6. Reservation of Seats for Economically Weaker Sections in general category: On the basis of G.O (M.S) No.128/2020/H.Edn dated 20.03.2020, 10 % reservation for Economically weaker sections (EWS) will be filled to the registered students who belongs to the Economically Weaker Sections among Forward Community by the University in the affiliated training college (other than minority institutions) where reservation to Other backward classes are provided. (U.O.No. 4958/2020/Admn Dated, 29.05.2020 & U.O.No. 7158/2020/Admn Dated,28.07.2020). For this purpose 10 % seats are additionally created over and above the sanctioned intake. Format for EWS certificate is attached as **Annexure 1 & 2** .

7. Selection and Indexing for admission to B.Ed Special Education (Hearing Impaired)

Marks/Grade obtained by the candidates at the Degree examination will be converted into percentage score. This mark/grade will be converted in to 1000.

In this index score, additional weightage may be given as follows:

For PG degree

MA/M Sc - First Class - 5 points

MA/M SC- Second Class- 3 points

MA/M sc - Third Class - 1 points

Candidates who belong to the area under the jurisdiction of the University of Calicut will be given a weightage of 15 marks scored by the candidate in their Degree examinations concerned. Such candidates should produce a nativity certificate issued by the Village Officer/Tahasildar. 5 marks weightage will be given to candidates who have taken Degree , Post graduation (Commerce and Computer Science/Electronics, MBA,MCA, Home Science only, MSW) from University of Calicut.

Those who have undergone N.C.C. Training with minimum 75% of attendance as stipulated in G.O. No. 673/04/H.Edn. dt. 15/04/94 will be given an additional of 5 marks. This will be added to the aggregate marks secured by the candidate in the qualifying Degree or PG as the case may be for B.Ed admission. NSS candidates /Students worked in the illiteracy Eradication programme are eligible for 5 marks in their admission to B.Ed course.

8. Resolving of Tie: The admission of students who obtained same index marks/points shall be decided first on the basis of age and then by name in alphabetical order unless otherwise specified.(U.O.No. GA1/A2/7226/2000 dated 04/05/2001)

9. Mode of Registration : Online

The online registration through centralized admission process will be conducted in Two stage.

9.1. PROCEDURE OF APPLICATION

Candidates applying for B.Ed Special Education Hearing Impaired -2020 shall visit the University

admission website www.cuonline.ac.in and access the B.Ed 2020 registration page and complete the registration in the following two steps:

9.1.1 **Stage I - CAP ID Creation** : Candidate applying for B.Ed Special Education Hearing Impaired -2020 shall initially create a CAP ID by selecting **B.Ed Special Education Hearing Impaired** using the "**NEW CAP REGISTRATION**" link provided in the B.Ed 2020 registration page. After successful submission of the details, CAP ID and Password will be sent to the registered mobile number instantly (Mobile number of students/ parents/guardian only to be furnished). **Registration Completion:** With the CAP ID and Password received in the registered mobile number, the candidate can login and fill the registration page by providing required data. Candidates shall take utmost care while selecting the reservation category, weightage etc during the filling up of registration data.

Four steps to complete the B.Ed Special Education Hearing Impaired Registration

- a) Basic Details
- b) Academic Qualifications
- c) College Selection
- d) Index

Candidate should verify the data given in the **verification page** (On verifying if there exists any mistakes, edit the application using **Edit Registration** button). After the verification, click on the "**Proceed to Payment**" button and make payment.

During the payment, the website will be redirected to the University of Calicut Instant Web Payment System (CUIWPS) page where the student can select the Payment Mode and make payment.

9.1.2. **Stage II -Payment for completing the Registration process-** Payment of fee for online registration can be made only through e-payment system (SBI online/SBI e-chalan/ payment gateway system/ Friends Janasevana Kendram/Akshayakendras)

9.1.2 (a) **Online Registration Fee**

For General Category candidates : Rs. **555/-**

For SC/ST : Rs. **170/-**

9.1.3. **Print out of application** -After successful payment, candidate should sign the **Declaration** and "**Finalise**" the document and can take the print out of application. No editing will be available after finalising the application.

Note 1 : Candidates who made their payment through SBI e-chalan/ Friends Janasevana Kendram/Akshayakendras will have to re-login to take the print out of the application.

Note 2 : In case, the payment fails, the candidates will have to re-login and do the payment procedure once again to complete the payment and obtain the print out of the application.

9.1.3.1 **Print out of the application will be provided only if the payment is successful.** Candidate's application will be considered complete only if he/she has completed the above mentioned steps and is holding a finalised printout showing approved stamp on the candidate's photo.

9.1.3.2 The print out of Online application and chalan/payment slips need not be sent to the University, but candidates are directed to keep the same with themselves and shall submit it to the colleges where he/she gets admission". Delayed, incomplete or defective applications will be

summarily rejected without notice. *If candidates couldn't take the print out due to the covid situation, print out of the application will be available in student login in www.cuonline.ac.in/B.Ed. Candidates should submit the Online B.Ed Special Education Hearing Impaired application at the time of admission.*

10. Admission

There is no online allotment for Special Education(Hearing Impaired) B.Ed programme in AWH college of Teacher Education,Kozhikode. University will forward the Rank list of online registered students to the College. College will conduct admissions as per the admission schedule published by the University. Candidates or representatives of the candidates are permitted to attend on the date prescribed for admission in AWH College of Education, Calicut.

11. Documents to be attached

- a) S.S.L.C (Secondary School Leaving Certificate)
- b) Qualifying Degree (Degree/P.G.) Certificate
- c) Marklists of Qualifying Degree Exam. (Part I, II & III)/Consolidated grade Card & of higher qualifications, if any.
- d) Equivalency Certificate from the University of Calicut in case of candidates who passed the qualifying examinations from Universities outside Kerala.
- e) Transfer Certificate (obtained from the last institution studied) and Conduct Certificate (obtained within 6 months)
- f) Nativity Certificate from the Village Officer in respect of those who are eligible for Nativity Weightage.
- g) Community Certificate from the competent Authority in the case of SC/ST/OEC/ ETB/MU/OBH/LC and SIUC candidates.
- h) Non-creamy layer certificate /Income Certificate in the case of candidates eligible for admission under community reservation.
- i) Medical Certificate for Visually/Orthopaedically Handicapped (Percentage of disability should be specified in the certificate issued by the Govt. Medical Board).
- j) Experience Certificate in Form IV of KER for claiming admission under Teachers Quota and for getting Weightage for teaching experience for those applying under Merit Quota. These Certificates should be signed by the Head of the School and Counter signed by A.E.O./D.E.O/Regional Deputy Director in the case of HSST.
- k) A certificate from the Head Master stating that the teacher has applied through proper channel for eligible leave to undergo B. Ed course should be produced.
- l) Certificate from the competent authority claiming Ex-Service/Wife of Ex-Service/Other Dependents of Ex-Service/Wife of serving personnel/Other dependants of serving personnel, in the case of Ex-service Quota, should be produced.
- m) Any other certificates from the competent authorities for the claim for admission under any specific quota weightage viz. Sports/Linguistic minority/N.C.C/N.S.S. etc. If any of these documents is not produced, the Head of the Institution has the right to summarily reject the claim for admission.
- n) A community certificate along with the Income & Assets Certificate (Ref: G.O.(Ms) No.128/2020/HEDN Dated 20.03.2020) issued from Village Officers/ Thahasildar should be produced by the candidates who wish to avail reservation under EWS category at the time of admission.

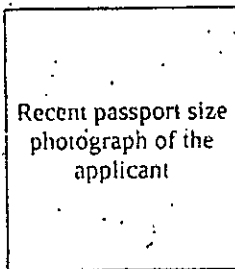
